Inter-Departmental Offshore Regatta (IDOR) 2013

UKHO - CSSA Charity Cup

With just about three weeks left to go the pre-event sales of the UKHO Commemorative chart are exceeding expectations. The plan has been revised and will be that we continue to push the pre-event sales and just bring the remaining number of charts to the IDOR, to any interested party, from both of the UKHO yachts (Named "Endeavour" and "Challenger"). To avoid disappointment please place orders early as the remaining charts will be sold strictly on a first come first served basis.

The annual Civil Service Sailing Association (CSSA) Inter-Departmental Offshore Regatta (IDOR) is again hosted this year by the Island Sailing Club with racing taking place inside the Solent and around the Isle of Wight from 19th – 24th May 2013.

This popular event has been running since the late 1960's and through various forms of sponsorship has raised money for numerous charities.

The United Kingdom Hydrographic Office are entering two teams for the 2013 edition and have utilised their world renown skills to produce a commemorative, limited edition chart (only 150 copies, all hand numbered) for this year's event. All proceeds from the sale of this chart will be split between the dedicated UKHO charity for 2013, **FreeWheelers** (www.freewheelers.org.uk) and a sailing related charity adopted by the UKHO IDOR sailing team, **Sail4Cancer** (www.sail4cancer.org).

This commemorative chart is derived from one of the most popular and Iconic charts within the UKHO catalogue (No. 2045) and is enhanced with images relating to the 2013 event. Together with a listing of Skippers names and Departments entered and the proposed course of the IDOR Round the Island Race. The size of the chart is 780mm (30.7") x 490 mm (19.3") and is produced in full colour on the UKHO's special heavy grade chart paper.

Or charts can be purchased at the event from either of the UKHO yachts for a price of £10.50 to be travel packaged in a sealed cardboard tube. 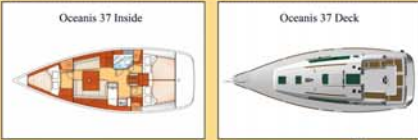
